

## Conflict and humanitarian situation in the Middle East

Dear colleagues,

In its resolution CERN/3626 dated 8 March 2022, the Council recalled: '... That the fundamental values of the Organisation have always been based on scientific collaboration across borders as an instrument of peace ...'.

For too many months now, we have been witnessing a humanitarian catastrophe in the Middle East. The Staff Association can no longer remain silent. We have therefore decided to send the letter below to the President of the Council and our Director-General, reflecting the reactions of many members of the CERN community.

Mr. President of Council, Madam Director-General,

This conflict brings suffering to all.

While fully recognising the restraint and impartiality required of us as international civil servants, the Staff Association wishes to reaffirm its unwavering commitment to CERN's primary objective, Science in the service of peace and humanity, as well as to the fundamental principles of human rights as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms.

In doing so, the Staff Association emphasises that the sanctity of human life must be protected, that violence and terror cannot build the future of humanity, and that it is the duty of each one of us – as individuals, nations and international organisations – to avoid hate speech but promote non-violence, peace, dialogue, compassion and understanding in order to defend the human rights of all.

In support of these convictions, the Staff Association wishes to express its thoughts and deepest sympathy to all members of personnel whose lives, families and loved ones have been or are currently affected by this conflict.

As part of its mandate, the Staff Association offers advice and support and invites these colleagues to come forward if they need help. The Staff Association is confident that the Organisation will do the same, as it has done in the past.

CERN must continue to be a voice for a peaceful scientific cooperation, giving support to its community.

## Conflit et situation humanitaire au Moyen-Orient

Chers collègues,

Dans sa résolution CERN/3626 en date du 8 mars 2022, le Conseil rappelait : « ...Les valeurs fondamentales de l'Organisation ont toujours été fondées sur la collaboration scientifique au-delà des frontières, comme instrument de paix... ».

Depuis plusieurs mois, nous sommes témoins d'une situation humanitaire dramatique au Moyen-Orient. L'Association du Personnel ne peut plus rester silencieuse. Nous avons donc décidé d'adresser la lettre ci-dessous au Président du Conseil et à notre Directrice générale, reflétant les préoccupations de nombreux membres de la communauté CERN.

Monsieur le Président du Conseil, Madame la Directrice générale,

Ce conflit engendre des souffrances pour tous.

Tout en reconnaissant pleinement la retenue et l'impartialité requises de notre part en tant que fonctionnaires internationaux, l'Association du Personnel souhaite réaffirmer son engagement constant envers l'objectif premier du CERN : la science au service de la paix et de l'humanité, ainsi qu'aux principes fondamentaux des droits humains tels qu'inscrits dans la Déclaration universelle des droits de l'homme et dans la Convention européenne de sauvegarde des droits de l'homme et des libertés fondamentales.

Dans ce contexte, l'Association du Personnel souligne que la protection de la vie humaine est primordiale, que la violence et la terreur ne peuvent construire l'avenir de l'humanité, et que chacun d'entre nous – individus, États et organisations internationales – a le devoir de promouvoir la non-violence, la paix, le dialogue, la compassion et la compréhension, afin de défendre les droits humains de tous.

Pour témoigner de ces convictions, l'Association du Personnel exprime sa pensée et sa plus profonde sympathie à tous les membres du personnel dont la vie, la famille ou les proches ont été, ou sont actuellement, affectés par cette situation.

Dans le cadre de son mandat, l'Association du Personnel propose son soutien et invite ces collègues à se manifester s'ils ont besoin d'aide. Elle est convaincue que l'Organisation agira de même, comme elle l'a fait par le passé.

Le CERN doit continuer à être une voix en faveur d'une collaboration scientifique pacifique et à soutenir sa communauté.

Veuillez agréer, Monsieur le Président du Conseil, Madame la Directrice générale, l'expression de nos salutations distinguées.
